#### A Good Association

This month we come to the first part of the name of our denomination, "Associate." This may be the most confusing part of the ARP name, but it may also be the most distinguishing. I have often recommended a recently published book written by Sinclair Ferguson, entitled *The Whole Christ*, as it helps explain the importance of a controversy that took place in Scotland nearly 300 years ago, called The Marrow Controversy. It was the Marrow Controversy which played a major role in forming our denomination, and which gave rise to the "Associate" in our denomination's name.

In the early 1700s in the Church of Scotland, a large number of ministers belonged to a group that became known as the Neonomians (meaning "new law"). These Neonomians taught that the gospel was a "new law" which replaced the Old Testament law with legal conditions of faith and repentance before the gospel could be offered. In other words, there was a necessity of forsaking sin <u>before</u> Jesus Christ could be preached and salvation offered to individuals.

Such teaching was a serious misunderstanding of the gospel. The danger of this teaching was exposed in an important book called *The Marrow of Modern Divinity*, and this shaped the preaching of such ministers as Thomas Boston and the Erskine brothers, Ralph and Ebenezer (a new edition of this book was publish a few years ago, and it is also recommended). They rightly saw that while faith and repentance are the results of the gospel and that sin must be forsaken, these are not to be treated as meritorious good works that earn or cause salvation. We are saved only by the free grace of God in Jesus Christ, not because of anything we have done. The gospel is to be preached and offered freely to men and women that they might come to know Christ and be saved.

This free offer of the gospel proved to be controversial in the Church of Scotland. The Marrowmen, as they were called, were formerly rebuked. Later controversies caused these ministers to be forced out of the Church of Scotland. Instead of being divisive, they met at a small town called Gairney Bridge and formed what they called an "Associate Presbytery." Their desire was to remain a part of the Church of Scotland while being temporarily separate until gospel preaching once again returned.

This reflection on the history of our denomination is a reminder that we come from a faithful group that values the preaching of the gospel of Jesus Christ. ARPs recognize that "faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God" (Romans 10:17). ARPs are "evangelical" from the first word of their name!
