DECEMBER 2010: 'The Miraculous Ushered In By The Unexpected' "Therefore the Lord Himself will give you a sign: Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a Son, and shall call His name Immanuel." (Isa. 7:14) "For unto us a Child is born, unto us a Son is given; and the government shall be upon His shoulder. And His name will be called Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. Of the increase of His government there will be no end, upon the throne of David and over His kingdom, to order and establish it with judgment and justice from that time forward, even for evermore. The zeal of the Lord of hosts will perform this." (Isaiah 9:6&7)

I sometimes wonder why those religious leaders at the time of our Lord's birth did not or could not understand the reports that had come to their ears concerning the birth of Jesus. Perhaps they were not expecting it. After all, hundreds of years have passed since the prophecies regarding the promised Messiah. It reminds me of what Peter said regarding the last days. "Knowing this first: that scoffers will come in the last days, saying, 'Where is the promise of His coming? For since the father's fell asleep, all things remain the same as they were from the beginning of creation.'" (2 Peter 3:3&4) Perhaps they simply did not believe the Messiah would ever come, which would have meant they did not believe God's word.

They and we forget what Isaiah reminds us; "For My thoughts are not your thoughts, nor are your ways My ways says the Lord. For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are My ways higher than your ways, and My thoughts than your thoughts." (Isaiah 55:8&9) As finite minds cannot comprehend the vastness of God's doings, yet we do just that. We try and figure things out down to the details, and when they do not add up, we deny the possibility of something happening which cannot be empirically determined.

Our problem with disbelieving the virgin birth and the coming of the Messiah is secularism. We tend to equate Jesus with Santa. Our culture cannot tolerate anything which may hint of the miraculous. The very words Christmas and Merry Christmas offends the minds of those who desire to see everything related to Christianity eradicated from the public scene.

At the incarnation, God's miraculous means of providing salvation for the human race was taking place in the most unusual and unexpected way. A poor, completely unknown, unimportant virgin Jewish girl would conceive and bear a Son and was told to name Him Jesus, "for He will save His people from their sin." Those who were wise in their own understanding completely missed out on this unbelievable and earth shattering event. My prayer is that we would never grow tired of hearing this good news that Jesus, the promised Messiah, came fulfilling all scriptures, and His desire is to live in our lives that we would never forget His great love and care for us. May we experience the Lord Jesus in ways which allow us to sing a new song of praise to our God!
